- Treasury Report (Anthony C.) – Anthony went over the budget details.
 - Willie's Spirit Night Earned: \$70.79
 - Current Expenses: \$1,336.41-Buyers' Gifts, \$306-Pickles, \$345-Show Lunches, and \$4,450 (divided into 2 payments)-Bus
- LSA Report (Wade D.) – Our Livestock Show was a success and a huge thank you to all of the volunteers. A special thank you to our Buyers' Gift Committee. Parking was an issue due to weather causing people to get stuck and the lack of volunteers. The option of having CFISD Police Dept. has come up. There are also talks to expand the Exhibit Center Building on next bond issue.
- Spring Brisket Fundraiser (Marcus L.) – March 23 and 24
 - Due to higher cattle prices briskets, we had to increase the sell amount of each brisket to \$70.
